



# Coldstream Hills

## Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon 1995

The 1995 Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon was produced entirely from the single 1.25-hectare block of Cabernet on the home Coldstream Hills vineyard planted in 1988. Right from the outset, this block has produced exceptional Cabernet Sauvignon, and has been the sole source for the 1992 to 1995 vintages. The weight and concentration have varied according to the vintage, but the style has remained constant.

The wine spent twenty-two months in a mix of new and used French oak barriques.

## Winemaker Comments: James Halliday



### Colour

Medium, red-purple in colour.



### Nose

Perfectly ripened varietal Cabernet supported by subtle and well integrated cedary French oak.



### Palate

The wine is of medium to full intensity with cassis/blackberry fruit, subtle cedary oak and lingering soft tannins. The excellent balance and easy feel of the wine in the mouth should not deceive; it will in fact be long lived.
