Coldstream Hills was established in 1985 by James and Suzanne Halliday. Situated in the cool and beautiful Yarra Valley, its steep, close planted vineyards have become a signature of the region.

The 1995 vintage favoured pinot noir, with all of the grapes being harvested before any significant vintage rain, and with average yields. The wines have plenty of fruit weight and varietal character. All in all, it was a good year for pinot noir, although very strict selection criteria were used for this wine.
