



Coldstream Hills

Varietal Sauvignon Blanc 2000

Forming an integral part of the Coldstream Hills varietal range, the 2000 Sauvignon Blanc was made principally from our grapes grown in the Upper Yarra Valley and a small portion of grapes from our Coldstream Vineyard. In keeping with the previous styles, a small proportion was barrel fermented in French oak to help add texture and complexity.

In total contrast to 1999, the 2000 vintage will be remembered as one of the warmest and driest on record. The sauvignon blanc vines thrived in these conditions producing grapes with excellent flavour and acidity.
