Vintage conditions: A mild Spring, followed by a warm and very dry ripening period led to a heightened onset of vintage. Despite a compressed harvest period, Pinot Noir held up well producing wines of flavour, texture and depth.

Eleven months in French oak – forty two percent new with the remainder in seasoned French oak barriques.

Colour Vibrant cherry/crimson with purple hue.

Bouquet Ripe and fragrant, with an array of wild strawberry, cranberry and raspberry fruit characters dominating. Hints of five-spice, graphite-like mineral and French oak add complexity and harmony.

Palate Medium-bodied in style with great texture, suppleness and length of flavour. Vibrant dark cherry, cranberry and strawberry notes are underpinned by beautifully integrated French oak, hints of spice and graphite-like mineral. Complex and layered, the palate is complete with a powdery chalk tannin finish.
